2018 Scholarship Criteria

SCHOLARSHIP

To emphasize the importance of education and our desire to have post secondary graduates as well as current undergraduates enter the mechanical contracting industry, the Mechanical Contractors Association of Canada and MASCO have established *The Delta Scholarship Program*.

OBJECTIVE

To provide financial support for deserving applicants attending recognized post-secondary institutions in the field of mechanical engineering and to encourage such individuals to attain a high level of academic achievement.

RECOGNIZED PROGRAM - DEGREE/DIPLOMA

Degree and/or diploma courses offered by Canadian Universities and Community Colleges will be given primary consideration. Should there be no candidates in the above programs; consideration may be extended to other courses by various recognized institutions providing the intent of the scholarship program is met.

ELIGIBILITY

The scholarship fund will be awarded to a member of an MCA Student Chapter or to a dependent of a full-time employee of a mechanical contracting firm. The firm must be a member of the Mechanical Contractors Association of Canada and have been in good standing for at least one year. The firm's membership must be verified by the senior executive officer of the province or zone operation. A student must not otherwise receive a major scholarship or bursary.

BASIS OF SELECTION

Applicants must be enrolled in a full-time post secondary program leading to a degree, certificate, or diploma from an accredited Canadian university or college. Significant preference will be given to those in educational programs related to the construction industry and in particular, the mechanical field. Further aspects of selection include academic achievement (a minimum "B" average from the previous year), demonstrated interest in the construction industry, work experience, extra-curricular activity, references, and financial need.
