The Electrician reports to the Manager of Maintenance and the Trades Supervisor –Electrical.

Duties include:

- Installs, maintains and repairs electrical services in buildings including renovations and modifications.
- Programs, monitors and services computerized heating systems; and services pneumatic heating systems, fans and circulating pumps etc.
- Performs preventive maintenance on all electrical equipment, such as fire alarms, security systems, etc.
- Troubleshoots and repairs electrical/electronic equipment such as P.A. 's, score clocks, fire alarms, security systems, etc.
- Orders related supplies and equipment.
- Represents school district at government electrical inspections of sites
- Provides estimates and advice on electrical projects.
- Reports unsafe situations.
- Keeps a detailed account of work performed for the computerized costing system.
- Operates power and manual tools related to the job such as computer, drills, meters, etc.
- Other work as assigned in other classifications in times of emergency

Required Knowledge and Skills:

- Trade qualification BCTQ as an Electrician
- Recent related experience
- Proven ability to work with minimal supervision
- Excellent troubleshooting skills
- A valid BC class 5 driver's license
